The End of the World As We Know It Checklist #1 – The Prophetic Checklist

Matthew 24:3 – “And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? And **what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?”**

ITEM	FULFILLED	DESCRIPTION
1.		<p>PROPHECY - Matthew 24:5 “For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.”</p> <p>FULFILLED: There are multitudes of Christian denominations whose leaders come in the name of Christ and say (bear witness) that Jesus is the Christ (the Son of the living God). Sadly, many followers have been deceived by them through erroneous teachings and doctrines. (Reference: Christianity Today article)</p>
2.		<p>PROPHECY - Matthew 24:6 “And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.”</p> <p>FULFILLED: Russia’s war on Ukraine as well as other less known wars going on in the world today are proof of this scripture. China’s rumored invasion of Taiwan is also proof. (Reference: World Population Review – Wars Today)</p>
3.		<p>PROPHECY – Matthew 24:7 “For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.”</p> <p>FULFILLED: The term ‘nation’ taken from the original Greek translation is <i>ethnos</i>; meaning <i>ethnicity</i>. Today’s world has many examples of ethnicity-against-ethnicity. And there are countries (kingdoms) which are against other countries. The US is beginning to experience famine conditions with drought and food shortages; other countries are undergoing famines. Pestilences (diseases/sicknesses), have been our reality since COVID-19. Since 2012, there have been 137,827 earthquakes registering between 4.0 thru 9.9 on the Richter scale (not including earthquakes below 4.0). (References: Famine, Pestilence, Earthquakes)</p>
4.		<p>PROPHECY – Matthew 24:10 “And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.”</p> <p>FULFILLED: What we witness in society today, are people being easily offended over many types of important or trivial issues. People are betraying one another based on which side of a particular issue they stand. Hate is at an all time high. No</p>

		longer is society in the place where people could still get along despite which side of an issue they stood. (References: Psychology Today , UpJourney , Pew Research)
5.		<p>PROPHECY – Matthew 24:11 “And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.”</p> <p>FULFILLED: Many false prophets flourished in the time of Elijah (1 Kings 18:19) when religion was an influential component of society and government. Today, false prophets can be equated to media (news networks, social networks, and tabloids) that is an influential component of society. This is not a stretch as Merriam-Webster defines <i>prophet</i> as thus: “<i>an effective or leading spokesman for a cause, doctrine, or group.</i>” (References: various types of news and social media)</p>
6.		<p>PROPHECY – Matthew 24:12 “And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.”</p> <p>FULFILLED: ‘<i>Iniquity</i>’ or ‘<i>inequity</i>’ in this sense refers to injustice or unfairness. Look at the push today for equity in the US alone, whether the cause is just or unjust, it has created ‘love for fellow man’ to grow cold. Dangerous prisoners who should be locked up are released and cause more harm to society, while parents in the Virginia school system are marked as ‘terrorists’ because they want to have a say in what their children are learning (these are just two examples of inequity). (Reference: Stanford University study on ‘Inequity’)</p>
7.		<p>PROPHECY – Matthew 24:14 “And <u>this</u> gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; <u>and then shall the end come.</u>”</p> <p>UNFULFILLED: Any day or any hour now, the end of what we’ve known this world to be will come to a close because Jesus said it would; just as the previously listed prophecies have come to pass. When the world comes into this knowledge of this gospel; that it will be judged by going through “The Great Tribulation,” then the end of this dispensation will come; where the church escapes through being raptured by Christ and those that are left behind will face tragedy that the world has never known before. Are you ready? Are you worthy to escape?</p>

1.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>1 Corinthians 6:9-10 “Know ye not that the unrighteous <u>shall not inherit the kingdom of God</u>? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.</p> <p>Ten classes not to be saved:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fornicators (the immoral, 1Cor. 6:9) 2. Idolaters (false worshipers, 1Cor. 6:9) 3. Adulterers (the unfaithful, 1Cor. 6:9) 4. Effeminate (catamites, 1Cor. 6:9) 5. Abusers of themselves with mankind (sodomites, homosexuals, pederasts, lesbians (1Cor. 6:9) 6. Thieves (robbers, 1Cor. 6:10) 7. Covetous (the lustful, 1Cor. 6:10) 8. 2.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Matthew 7:21-23 “Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.”</p> <p>Saying you’re a believer IS NOT good enough: No person merely professing faith in Jesus and His atoning work will be saved, "but he that doeth the will of My Father" (Mt. 7:21; 1Pet. 4:18; Heb. 12:14; Jas. 1:19-27 Rom. 6:16-23; 8:12-13). These are religious folks, who think they are okay with God simply because they are involved in religious activity, yet they have no personal relationship with God. Relationships are built upon interactions one has with another. The religious have many interactions with their churches and leaders of them, but have NO interactions with God himself.</p>

John 14:6 “Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. John 14:6”

The Way: Jesus in the entry (door) and this entry comes by way of salvation (being born again) - “He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.” (John 3:36)

The Truth: Jesus is the knowledge that we must live by after coming through the entry of eternal life at the day of salvation. – “But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.” (Matthew 4:4)

The Life: The life of Jesus through the Holy Spirit is the result of our transformation when we walk by faith in His word. Our lives essentially are a manifestation of God’s word that lives in our hearts. – “Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing. If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.” (John 15:4-6)

You Cannot Come to God: This is the route one must take to get to God the Father and it is ALL through Jesus. He is the ‘entry’ (the way/salvation), He is the ‘pathway’ (the truth/knowledge to God), and He is the ‘journey’ (the life/the transformed life); there is no other way to God outside of this course.

1.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>What to do: Give your life to God; get saved and become born again.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Acts 2:21 “And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.”• Romans 10:9-11 “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. ¹¹ For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.”• John 3:16-17 “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.”
2.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Live for the Lord: Make the learning of Jesus and God the Father your life</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Matthew 4:4 “But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.”• Colossians 3:4-10 “When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory. Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience: In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them. But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:”• Matthew 16:24-27 “Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it. For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?”

ASK GOD TO SAVE YOU: Be truly repentful of all your sins; ask God earnestly to forgive and save you. Acknowledge that He sent Jesus to die the death you alone were worthy of and receive his substitutionary sacrifice as the price paid for your sins. Truly commit yourself to dedicate your life to learn God’s ways (study His word), to serve Him (Do His Will), love Him, and glorify Him (worship Him and ONLY Him).


What If You Miss the Rapture?

Checklist #4 – Endure the “Tribulation”

1.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>What to do: Give your life to God; get saved and become born again.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acts 2:21 “And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.” • Romans 10:9-11 “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. ¹¹ For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.” • John 3:16-17 “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.”
2.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>The first 3 ½ years: After the rapture takes place, make preparations during the first 3 ½ years of this 7-year tribulation period to learn how to become a survivalist. Purchase seeds for planting, fishing/hunting equipment for meat, survival filtration straws for water, tent/survival blanket for shelter. You have to learn to live off the land so that you do not succumb to the Antichrist’s financial system and the cruelty of other people violating you while trying to survive. If you live in a city, retreat to the rural areas and learn to live. By all means <u>DO NOT</u> take the mark; for that will seal your soul to eternal damnation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revelation 13:14-17 “And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live. And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed. And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.”
3.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>With the help of God and power of the Holy Spirit: After you give your life to God you must depend on Him even unto death.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revelation 14:9-13 “And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the

mark of his name. Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.”
